

**BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

- I. CALL TO ORDER:** The Parke County Board of Commissioners convened in a special meeting at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 23rd, 2014, having adjourned from a regular meeting at 5:12 p.m. on Monday, September 15th, 2014.
- II. ROLL CALL:** Members present were Commissioners Jim Meece, President; Greg Harbison, First Vice President; Dan R. BUSINESS:** The Parke County Board of Commissioners met in a special meeting to discuss a joint grant application in the amount of \$100,000.00 with the Town of Montezuma to make the old railroad bridge crossing the Wabash River in Parke and Vermillion counties usable for a trail. The required twenty (20) percent match could be met with volunteer labor. The Department of Natural Resources would maintain ownership of the bridge. Greg Harbison made a motion to pursue the grant as a co-applicant with the Town of Montezuma. Dan Collom seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
